



Walkway Auditor Certification Training for 2012



The National Floor Safety Institute's (NFSI) Walkway Auditor Training course is designed to provide the attendee with the necessary information on how to properly conduct a walkway safety inspection under OSHA's proposed new rule for "Walking and Working Surfaces" and bring you up to date on the recently released ANSI/NFSI B101.1-2009 floor safety standard. The Course covers:

- Step-by-step review of the NFSI Walkway Auditing Guideline
- OSHA's revised Walking and Working Surface Requirements
- How and why slips, trips and falls occur
- Floor covering materials and their recommended applications
- Proper floor maintenance methods and procedures
- Hands-on use of various walkway tribometers

Upon completion, participants will be issued a username and password to complete the online exam – you will have 30 days to complete the test. Participants that complete all four days and score an 80% or higher on the exam will be issued a certificate of completion and will be certified by NFSI as a Walkway Auditor Safety Specialist for three years. A one day review course will be provided to renew the certification every three years.
